Edible Homemade Play Dough

The author of this recipe says it is "the best homemade play dough recipe I've ever made ... and I've made a LOT!"

INGREDIENTS

- ½ cup all purpose flour
- ½ Tbsp. Canola oil
- 1/8 cup Salt
- ¼ cup boiling water
- 1 pack Kool-aid (any color)

INSTRUCTIONS

Mix all ingredients together WELL. Add flour if sticky. Make sure it is completely COOLED before use. Should not stain hands.

This homemade play dough recipe is made from normal household ingredients and will not harm the curious child who decides to take a lick ... but it is NOT meant for your child to eat or snack on.
